How we collect information: We get most of our information directly from you, such as personal and corporate financial statements. This information that you give us when applying for your bond(s) generally provides the information we need. If we need to verify this information or need additional information, we may obtain information from third parties such as consumer reporting agencies or banks.

How we protect information: We treat information in a confidential manner. Our employees are required to protect the confidentiality of information. Employees may access information only when there is an appropriate reason to do so, such as to underwrite a new bond or renew an existing bond. We also maintain physical, electronic and procedural safeguards to protect information; these safeguards comply with all applicable laws. Employees are required to comply with our established policies.

We do not share any information with any outside agency, except for the purpose of qualifying for bonding, which you have authorized.

When we do conduct business through our agents, we require our agents to maintain similar standards of conduct regarding the privacy of personally identifiable customer information provided to them.

Information disclosure: It is Pioneer General's policy **NOT** to reveal specific information about customers' files or other personally identifiable data to our agents or any unaffiliated third party for their independent use. We may disclose any information when we believe it is necessary for the conduct of our business or where the law requires disclosure. For example, information may be disclosed to our agents or others to enable them to assist us in processing a bond transaction requested by you. Information may also be disclosed for audit or research purposes or to law enforcement and regulatory agencies, for example, to help us prevent fraud. Information may be disclosed to affiliates as well as credit reporting agencies. Our affiliates may include our agents. We may make other disclosures of information as permitted or required by law.

We do **NOT** provide account or personal information to any company for the purpose of independent telemarketing or direct mail marketing of any products or services of those companies.

Should you ever believe that our records contain inaccurate information about you, please notify us. We will investigate your concerns and correct any inaccuracies that we have made.
